Here the fizz comes from secondary fermentation (therefore Champagne cork). "87/100. green apple and floral aromas. Bright and fresh. Finishes with decent length and a hint of sweetness." (Stephen Tanzer)

### 24. Henri Abelé Brut N.V.

*Champagne, France*

One of Champagne's oldest Grands Marques Houses, founded in 1757. It was served on board the Titanic! A bottle of Henri Abelé Brut was among the 7000 artefacts! "91/100...hints of ripe plum, toast, crunchy white peach and lemon pith, with a zesty, minerally underpinning on the palate.

- 02. Domaine des Lauriers Picpoul de Pinet Classic** £6<sup>.50</sup> £26<sup>.00</sup>  
*Languedoc, France*  
 "Fresh, clean and marine. Deep, pure and long, with lots of cool lime and lemon backed up by soft-contoured acidity." (Decanter, April 2019) Made by sustainable viticulture. Family run estate since 1969. Ideal with seafood.
- 03. Martín Códax Alba Albariño** £7<sup>.00</sup> £29<sup>.00</sup>  
*Rías Baixas, Spain*  
 "GOLD MEDAL" (Concurso Nacional de Vinos Jóvenes) Intense & elegant aromas of white stone fruits & white flowers. The proximity to the sea adds freshness, & the granitic soils enhance its natural minerality. Medium-bodied, fresh, with an impressive persistence.
- 04. The Jumper Sauvignon Blanc** £7<sup>.00</sup> £28<sup>.00</sup>  
*Marlborough, New Zealand*  
 Tiny boutique production of 10,000 cases per year! From Hunter's Winery, established by Belfast man Ernie Hunter.

- 05. Ameztoi Txakoli** £35<sup>.00</sup>  
*Getariako Txakolina, Basque Country, Spain*  
 "91/100. Pungent, mineral-laced aromas of pear, floral honey, lemon pith & fresh herbs. Densely packed orchard and citrus fruit flavors are brightened by zesty minerality and a hint of white pepper." (Tanzer's International Wine Cellar) For lighter seafood.
- 06. Domaine Alain Chavy Puligny-Montrachet 2017** £80<sup>.00</sup>  
*Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France*  
 Established in 1940. Les Chevalières is a small plot on the slopes just above Meursault. 50 year old vines. Notes of bee wax & honeysuckle-scented & is tightly wound & pure with excellent richness & depth as well as vibrant acidity. Flavours of toasted bread infused with tangy lemon.
- 07. Anselmo Mendes Muros Antigos Loureiro** £28<sup>.00</sup>  
*Minho, Portugal*  
 "90/100. The grapes are all sourced from the Lima Valley, the area most famed for Loureiro." (Mark Squires, Parker's Wine Advocate) Often used in a blend, this 100% Loureiro demonstrates a lot of tension, freshness & minerality. Flint, citrus fruits & iodine are the dominant notes in this incredible juice. Very structured & well defined. A must try!
- 08. Saladini Pilastrini Pecorino** £30<sup>.00</sup>  
*Marche, Italy*  
 "88/100. certified ORGANIC since 1994. Its Pecorino has good varietal typicity: mid-straw yellow hue, a nose fragrant with firm lemony fruit, jasmine and herbs, and some peachy ripeness. It's steel aged – no oak – and has good weight. Crisp and aromatic, it's worth trying as an alternative to Sauvignon Blanc or Pinot Grigio." (Amy Wislocki, Decanter 30.01.21.)
- 09. Zöhrer Sand 1 Riesling** £32<sup>.00</sup>  
*Niederösterreich, Austria*

- 13. Porta 6 Reserva** £6<sup>.50</sup> £28<sup>.00</sup>  
*Lisboa, Portugal*  
 Porta 6 has become one of our most popular wines. Many people thought it was impossible to improve, but Vidigal who like a challenge, have just released the Porta 6 RESERVA. - 14. Domaine des Anges Côtes du Ventoux** - Rhône, France £7<sup>.50</sup> £29<sup>.00</sup>

- 17. Cuatro Pasos Mencía** £30<sup>.00</sup>  
*Bierzo, Spain*  
 NEW! "87/100. Spicy plum & cassis aromas come with a sweet note of cinnamon-infused jam." (Wine Enthusiast) "This sleek red shows a savory character, with sanguine & licorice notes framing a core of berry & loamy earth. Firm acidity braces the polished texture." (Wine Spectator) 100% Mencía. Over 60 years old vines.2-3 months in French and American oak barrels.
- 18. Edgebaston The Berry Box Merlot** £32<sup>.00</sup>  
*Stellenbosch, South Africa*

- 21. Ascheri Barolo 2017** £65<sup>.00</sup>  
*Piedmont, Italy*
