Only produced in very good vintages. From Sangiovese grapes grown in selected areas of the Chianti, mainly Rufina & surroundings. Sangiovese 95%, Colorino 5%. 21.	Bosca Malbec <i>Mendoza, Argentina</i> 2018: "90/100. A Malbec from Luján de Cuyo and the Uco Valley that spent 12 months aging in French barrels... offers ripe plum and hints of violet over a gentle bed of oak.
